

# Annual Integrated Pest Management Notice

Dear Parent, Guardian, or Staff Member:

This notice is being distributed to comply with the New Jersey School Integrated Pest Management Act. The Hamilton Township School District has adopted and Integrated Pest Management (IPM) Policy and has implemented an IPM Plan to comply with this law. IPM is a holistic, preventive approach to managing pests that is explained further in the school's IPM Policy included with this notice.

All schools in New Jersey are required to have an Integrated Pest Management Coordinator (IPM Coordinator) to oversee all activities related to IPM and pesticide use at the school.

The IPM coordinator maintains the pesticide product label, and the Material Safety Data Sheet (MSDS) when one is available to parents, guardians, staff members or students attending the schools. Also, the IPM coordinator is available to parents, guardians, or staff members for information and to discuss comments about the IPM activities and pesticide use at the school.

As part of a school pest management plan Hamilton township Public School District may use pesticides to control pests. The United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) register pesticides to determine that the use of a pesticide in accordance with instructions printed on the label does not pose an unreasonable risk to human health and the environment. Nevertheless, the EPA and the DEP cannot guarantee that registered pesticides so not pose a risk to human health, thus unnecessary exposure to pesticides should be avoided. The EPA has issued that statement that where possible, persons who are potentially sensitive, such as pregnant woman, infants and children, should avoid unnecessary pesticide exposure.

## **The following items must be included with this annual notice:**

- A copy of the school district's IPM policy.
- The date, time and place of any meeting if the one is to be held for the purpose of adopting or modifying the school's integrated pest management policy or plan.
- A list of pesticides that are in use or that have been used in the past 12 months on school property.
- The current school year's list of Pesticides and Herbicides used.
